I know the Newsletter can be a little long, but can I encourage you to read it all as it does contain a lot of important information and if there is anything you would like to speak to us about, please do not hesitate to do so by either text, phone or e-mail.

Please refrain from messaging on Facebook as we do not always get these messages, or see them.

Our Term Dates, Colour of the week, Important Dates for Your Diary and Song of the week can be found at the end of this Newsletter. Please take a look as this is very important information.

Please can we ask that the children refrain from wearing jewellery to pre-school, except for stud earrings. We have had a few incidents including necklaces being pulled and broken as well as being a choking hazard!!

Please ensure that you inform us of any changes in your e-mail address and phone numbers. We communicate, mostly, through e-mail and text, rather than paper, and it is essential that we have the correct contact information.

We cannot stress enough how important it is to keep everyone safe from coughs, colds and infectious disease, where possible. If your child has a raised temperature or is not feeling their normal self, please keep them home until they are feeling better. We know this can be difficult for working parents, but we cannot stress enough how important it is for the children to be warm and cosy at home to recover and get better to come back to pre-school and be with their

friends and teachers. Can we remind you that if your child is sick or/and has an upset tummy, you must not bring them into pre-school until 48 hours after their last episode. This is so important as we need to ensure that the children and Team are safe from catching any bugs!!

This half term our topic will be "Celebrations". We will be taking part in activities and looking at festivals around the world including Christmas, Diwali, Hanukkah, Remembrance Day and Bonfire Night. In craft, we will be making cards, clay decorations and pots, rangoli patterns, menorah's, a wish list and firework pictures. For the week beginning 10th November, for Children In Need, we can wear our pyjamas to pre-school. We will be going on a Bear Hunt and be using our compare bears to match sizes, count and find how many? In December, we will be preparing for our end of term Christmas Party and Concert that we will be learning some songs to sign and sing to you. We will also make our playdough each week to match our Colour Of The Week and be learning songs and sounding out our letters with Jolly Phonics and for the older children going to school next September, we will begin our Nursery Narrative programme and will be looking at "Me".

Please continue to use the hand sanitiser provided for both you and your child when dropping off and picking up. All of children have their temperature taken first thing and throughout the day and if their temperature is high, you will be asked to come and collect them.

LET'S STAY SAFE AND DO WHAT WE CAN to still prevent contamination!!!

Can we also ask that when dropping off and picking up your child/children, that you go into the playground and wait for a member of the team to be at the steps to take your child from you at drop off time or handing over to you at the end of their session. Please refrain from waiting on the pathway or coming down the steps. Thank you.

Extended Hours

We offer breakfast 8am-9am for Parents/Carers that may need that extra childcare. We are happy to take older siblings that need to be taken to Solent Infants or Juniors (Unfortunately we are unable to drop off at other schools in the area). If this is something you need, then please speak to Julia or Aimee or

drop us an e-mail. If you know anyone that this might help, please pass on our details. Can I also say that we can take children up to the age of 8 years of age, this means that children can come to us when on Inset Days. Again, please let us know if we can help or let anyone else you know that this might help.

Invoices

Please be reminded that if you are issued an invoice, it must be paid promptly to avoid arrears. Invoices need to be paid in full by return, and definitely before the end of each half term, as agreed in your payment policy. Full Payment by the last Wednesday of each half term has always been a gesture of good will from myself to help with spreading the payments, it is not a date for the invoice to be left unpaid until then. Therefore, I am asking that Invoices be paid by return. If you need to pay weekly over the half term, then you will need to agree this with me. I am sorry to have to change this, but it becomes very frustrating and embarrassing to have to chase for fees owing.

Please note that we do not accept cheques at Little Stars Pre-school.

Fees are as follows:

2-3 years - £7.20 per hour

3-4 years - £7.00 per hour

Extra sessions and lunches are to be paid on the day attending.

We are experiencing lunches and extra sessions not being paid for on the day, or in advance, as well as invoice payments being left right to the last minute and resulting in us having to chase for payments that can be a little embarrassing as well as worrying. Please ensure these payments are made promptly. Can I also remind you that if you require Breakfast Hour or 3-3.30pm please give us notice in advance even if the day/night before.

Collection of Children.

Please be reminded that if collecting your child before 12 noon or 3pm you will need to collect them before 11.45 or 2.45pm as to not disturb story time. We would also appreciate it if we know you are collecting early to enable us to have your child ready to bring them to you at the front door.

Lunches

Please can we remind you that we do not have sweets, this includes fruit winders and Bear products, chocolate bars etc, fizzy drinks or ANYTHING containing NUTS in our lunchboxes, that includes peanut butter as we can have children and staff with severe

allergies. We promote healthy eating and GRAPES AND LARGE BLUEBERRIES NEED TO BE SLICED LENGTHWAYS to avoid potential choking hazards. Can we also ask that an ice pack be placed in your child's lunch box please as we do not have a large fridge to store them in during the morning. We DO NOT heat any food for the children.

Being ready for all weathers

Please ensure your child has suitable clothing for both inside and outside with them in a named bag and all items have their name in. Autumn is here and the hall can be quite cold in the mornings until we come in and turn up the radiators. Please ensure that your child is dressed ready for the day with adequate changes of clothing, including suitable footwear. Please name all belongings including coats, shoes, hats, changing bags and lunch boxes. If your child wears wellington boots to pre-school, please supply a named change of shoes or slippers for us to change them into.

Pre-existing Injuries

It is essential that you let us know when you drop off if your child has a pre-existing injury, this could be a bump, bruise, rash or sore etc. You will need to complete a pre-existing injury form before leaving. If we discover a pre-existing injury after dropping off, we will contact you and complete a form that will need to be read and signed on collection.
